
JM.L: How did you experience the coronavirus crisis the world is experiencing?

You have to focus on sharing your uniqueness, who you really are and accept the imperfections. You also have to avoid comparing yourself to all the people you meet on social media. It's not the truth you see there.



JM.L : How do you see your evolution in the cinema, is there a role of accomplished woman that you would like to play?

R.N: I'm looking forward to playing ALL the characters I can play. Every character I can think of is a challenge for me.

JM.L : Among the festivals around the world, there is the one in Cannes in France. Do you know it AND does it make you dream?

R.N : Oh of course I'd like to go there, I have a lot of dreams in my head and I work a lot to make

them all come true !

JM.L : You've already been to Paris, in what context ? What did you enjoy? You are also a model, Paris still represents fashion according to you?

R.N: I LOVE PARIS SO MUCH! I've been there many times and each time I come, it's totally magical. It means a lot for fashion, but also for food and people. And EVERYTHING!

JM.L : What does wealth mean to you ? Is it a symbol of success? A desire for power? Something else?

R.N: I think wealth comes when someone does what is really your passion and works a lot for it. So yes, I think it's a sign of success.
